The journal is opened with an excerpt from the last work of O. Savchenko «The System of Interdisciplinary Tasks at the Literary Reading Lessons».

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SHEE «Donbas State Pedagogical University» *Inna Khyzhniak* and *Iryna Viktorenko* present the results of the scientific research on the level of the future primary school teachers' motivation development for the professional work under the conditions of the New Ukrainian school. PhD in Philology, Associate Professor at the Department of Pedagogy of Primary Education of Vasyl Stefanyk Precarpathian National University *Iryna Humeniuk* introduces the construction of the algorithm for organization of the independent work in the context of mastering the «Ukrainian for Professional Purposes» discipline by the applicants for higher education of the 012 Preschool Education and 013 Primary Education specialties. The tandem of Ph.D. in Pedagogical Sciences, Associate Professors *Yuliia Pavlenko* (Poltava V. G. Korolenko National Pedagogical University) and *Yuliia Lyamar* (T. H. Shevchenko National University «Chernihiv Colehium») reveals the system of the work built on the principles of museum pedagogy in a higher educational institution, and characterizes the means of its practical implementation in the process of the future primary school teachers' professional training. The article of Ph.D. in Pedagogical Sciences, Professor at the Department of Pedagogy and Methods of Primary Education of National Pedagogical Dragomanov University *Tetiana Vasiutina* reveals the content and organizational aspects of the future primary school teachers' training for the pupils' components of the nature competence formation by means of the interactive technologies. The article series is completed by the scientific work of Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, Professor at the Department of Preschool and Primary Education of T. H. Shevchenko National University «Chernihiv Colehium» *Tetiana Havrylenko*, devoted to grounding the methodological principles of the research of the primary education development in Ukraine in the second half of the XX – the beginning of the XXI centuries.

The section «Events, activities, reviews» presents the information about the First All-Ukrainian pedagogical readings in honor of the memory of O. Savchenko «Oleksandra Savchenko. The lessons of cooperation and communication» and about the cooperation of scientific and pedagogical workers of T. H. Shevchenko National University «Chernihiv Colehium» and National Pedagogical Dragomanov University.

The scientific journal contains the information about the new textbooks “Comparative Studies in Preschool and Primary Education” and “Methods of Teaching Calligraphic Writing in Primary School” for the applicants for higher education of the 012 Preschool Education and 013 Primary Education specialties.

It is important that this issue opens a new page in the history of the «New Inception» journal.
